- ◆ More than 8000 electronic full-text journals are available to WSU faculty, staff, and students. To see (or search) the WSU Libraries' complete list of electronic journals, visit the Article Indexes / E-Journals page and select "Electronic Journals Search and A-Z list."
Examples of online, full text journals include [JAVMA](#), [JAAHA](#), [Journal of Equine Veterinary Science](#), [Veterinary Surgery](#), [the Veterinary Clinics of North America](#) (all sections), etc.

- ◆ To see a list of all WSU's veterinary databases, click the "Databases by Subject" link, and choose "Veterinary Medicine" from the subject list. Then click on "Go".
- ◆ You may also select a database by clicking Databases A-Z and entering the name (PubMed, CAB, etc.)
- ◆ **Important:** Use the **FIND-IT** links to connect to full text articles, Griffin, and/or ILLiad in these databases.
- ◆ **CAB Abstracts** —1910- (veterinary references go back to 1931)
Includes references and abstracts from hundreds of veterinary journals and books. Updated monthly.

- ◆ **MEDLINE via PubMed** (1950-):
Contains references with abstracts to articles in over 4,600 biomedical journals covering all aspects of medicine. Includes indexing to 90 veterinary journals. Updated daily. For a tutorial (which lets you skip the parts you already know), go to:

Getting Materials Not Owned by WSU:

- ◆ **Journal Articles:** To order an article from another library, use ILLiad for desktop delivery of journal articles or book chapters. GPSA will pay the \$3.00 Level 1 standard fee for article photocopies or book loans. To register (and use) ILLiad, go to

Note: If you are doing a block away from Pullman, you can order articles from HSL journals via ILLiad, too. Be sure to note that you are away from Pullman and change your mailing address in ILLiad or the request will be returned unfilled.

- ♦ **Book Loans:** To request books owned by 30+ Washington and Oregon academic libraries, search SUMMIT from the Griffin Catalog. To place a request, use your network ID and password.

Creativity Stations: 2 computer work stations (located in the current journals area), with MS Office products, scanners, CD readers and burners, and networked to the color and black-and-white printers.

- ♦ **MEDLINE via PubMed (1950s--):** <http://www.pubmed.gov> Same database as used by WSU users, but contains links to only free full-text articles.
- ♦ **Agricola:** <http://agricola.nal.usda.gov/> - Same database is available to WSU users. Not as complete as CAB Abstracts. Coverage better for large animals than small.
- ♦ **Consultant:** <http://www.vet.cornell.edu/consultant/consult.asp> – Primarily a diagnostic database, but also contains selected current references to veterinary articles. Searchable by sign or diagnosis.
- ♦ **Veterinary Conference Proceedings:** <http://www.medvet.umontreal.ca/biblio/rech.htm>
A searchable index to various veterinary conference proceedings.
