

CONSTITUTION

Name of Organization: WSU-CVM International Veterinary Student Association (IVSA)

Purpose and Objectives: To further veterinary education by exposing students to different cultures and methods of veterinary practice by arranging student exchanges.

Qualifications for Membership:

Full members: Currently enrolled WSU veterinary students, and WICHE students

Associate members: WSU faculty/staff

The IVSA is open to all students regardless of race, religion, sex, color, national or ethnic origin, age, marital status or handicap.

Membership dues

Fundraising

Sponsorship by pharmaceutical and pet food companies

Student Chapter of American Veterinary Medical Association (SCAVMA)

Officers: The following officers will be elected by a simple majority of members:

President: Will work with the faculty advisor to plan all programs and activities and preside over meetings; arrange international exchanges, review applications and distribute funds.

President-Elect: A first year student who will become president in their second year, and who will assist the president and faculty advisor in reviewing applications and distributing funds, as well as assisting students in filling out applications for international travel.

Treasurer: Will collect membership dues, deposit dues and other income in the Controller's Office and keep a current record of club funds; assist in fundraising; will distribute funds to applicants for international travel.

Secretary: Will keep written records of meetings and activities as well as type and file documents, perform photocopying and faxing, care of library material, assist with poster and article writing.

Fundraising: Petition pet food and pharmaceutical companies; create advertising; general fundraising ideas and organization (including delegation of minor duties to other members of the club).

Parliamentary Procedures:

Revision of the constitution and/or addition of amendments will be voted on by a $\frac{3}{4}$ majority of currently enrolled WSU veterinary students only (full members). The president will vote only in case of a tie vote. The faculty advisor, associate and honorary members will not vote or hold office.
