

Most years, the first DC (DC I) is the second week in October and DC II is the week immediately preceding Thanksgiving week.

GENERIC DC WEEK FOR CLIENTS FOR A TUESDAY-FRIDAY DC (DC I):

It is important to review this schedule to make sure you are capable of making the time commitment necessary. Below is an example of a typical DC week. Although the schedule is sometimes a bit different, please note that the students are sometimes in class in the mornings until 9 AM. The times indicated by pink are times when students are working on their DC cases and are likely to need to meet with clients. DC clients are expected to be available (ideally on site at the CVM) during these times on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday. The times indicated by purple are times that students are working on their cases, but that clients are not expected to be on campus. Students will sometimes need or want to contact their client by phone during these times and possibly in the evenings. Many DC clients enjoy attending the Grand Rounds presentations on Thursday afternoon. The schedule and room numbers are available from your case facilitator.
