

Neuroscience Meeting Minutes on October 25th 2007.

I motioned to start the meeting at 5:30pm and Allyssa second.

Announcements were made about needing just a few volunteers for the faculty Christmas party. We will be sending out an email with the time comes closer.

The RSO grant cannot be turned in until spring because we have a “spring” seminar. We will apply for that in the spring.
