### **Research Proposal Instructions**

The maximum length of the proposal should not exceed three (3) pages. The information should be arranged in the following sections:

1. Introduction, including brief summary of background literature.
2. Specific aims of your project.
3. Briefly describe methods of procedure.
4. Progress to date.
5. Timetable – state how long you think it will take to complete the entire project. Also, state clearly what you expect to accomplish within the next year.
6. Significance of this research.
7. Your educational experience as it pertains to your proposed project (e.g., degrees, field of study, work experience, papers published).
8. Importance of this award in achieving your research goals.
9. Curriculum vitae may be included in addition to the three-page proposal.
