Jump-start your research!

THIS IS AN OPPORTUNITY to fund your research, organize a grant proposal, add substance to your CV, and potentially have your research published in the scientific quarterly, *Northwest Science*. The Northwest Scientific Association awards **grants of up to \$1,500** to support student research in the pure and applied sciences. **Undergraduate students are encouraged to apply.**

Applicants must be student members of NWSA. Visit the NWSA website at www.vetmed.wsu.edu/org_nws/NWSci_Home.htm for membership information. Grant monies may only be used to support research travel, materials, and supplies for student research (proposals requesting salary support or travel to meetings will *not* be considered). **Funding will only be offered for projects conducted in the Pacific Northwest.**

The deadline for all proposals is **midnight, 22 February 2011** (for electronic submission), **or postmarked by 22 February 2011** (if mailed to the chair of the Student Research Grant Committee). Awards will be announced in March 2011.
